You may apply for up to \$750 for a project that will be implemented during the 2021-2022 school year. Classroom teachers, school counselors, social workers, and others who require a license to work with enrolled students are eligible to apply.

Preference is given to innovative projects that:

- Improve student achievement/self-esteem
- Encourage parent/community involvement
- Improve curriculum, including distance learning

Other factors considered include the number of students served, the free and reduced-price lunch statistic of the school, and if the program could be replicated for future students.

Applications are due by: Monday, October 11, 2021 Awards will be granted week of November 15, 2021

Grant Financial Reports are due by Monday, April 25, 2022
